A block of rooms has been reserved for the event. **All rooms to receive the festival discount must be booked and complete before Monday, March 10th.** Rooms booked after the 10th will be at the hotel's regular room rates, which are substantially more. Festival discount is \$69.00 for a regular room and \$89.00 for a suite, *plus tax.

☀ Registration will begin Friday night at the Quality Inn from 6 to 8 pm. Ken will hold a Beginners' session from 6:30 to 8 pm at the hotel, with a jam to follow. Workshops on Saturday/Sunday will be held at the library; the Saturday night concert with Ken Bloom, Jeff and Janet Furman will be held at the First Baptist Church on Main Street, directly across the street from the library.
