Please make your own arrangements for accommodations at the **Quality Inn and Suites of Pilot Mountain**, 711 S. Key St., Pilot Mountain, NC - the "Official Hotel of the Pilot Mountain Bowed Dulcimer Festivals". You can do this by calling the local number, 336-368-2237 (800-780-7234 may work). When booking rooms, please be sure to ask for the **Bowed Dulcimer Festival discount**. A block of rooms has been reserved for the event. All rooms to receive the festival discount must be booked and complete before Sunday, Feb. 28, 2010. Festival discount is \$62.99 for a regular room and \$89.99 for a suite, \*plus tax. Rooms booked after Feb. 28 will be at the hotel's regular room rates, which are substantially more.

Registration will begin Friday night at the Quality Inn from 6 to 8 pm. Ken will hold a Beginners' session from 6:30 to 8 pm at the hotel, with a jam to follow. We will hold a jam for everyone else (all instruments welcome) in another room, and will plan to join the beginners at 8 pm. Workshops on Saturday 9 am to 5 pm and Sunday 9 am to noon will be held at the library; the Saturday night concert with Ken Bloom, Jeff and Janet Furman will be held at the First Baptist Church on Main Street, directly across the street from the library.
